# Drinking Water State Revolving Fund

## Program Overview

The Drinking Water SRF Program is a multifaceted tool for states to use to achieve the public health objectives of the Safe Drinking Water Act

Drinking Water SRF funds are used to



Protect Public Health



Ensure Compliance with Drinking Water Standards



Support Social Equity through Drinking Water Affordability Assessments



# Drinking Water State Revolving Fund

## Annual Funding

### State Program

- ❖ \$3.59 million (capped sales tax appropriation)  
Less \$2.20 million (federal program 20% state match)
- ❖ \$4.10 million (repayment)

### Federal Program

- ❖ \$11.00 million (federal appropriation)  
Less \$3.41 million (program implementation set-aside)
- ❖ \$2.20 million (20% state match)
- ❖ \$10.33 million (repayment)

# Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Current Fund Balance

# Drinking Water State Revolving Fund

## Eligible Applicants

Both programs are limited to public water systems that serve at least 25 people a day for 60 days a year

### State Program (R309-700)

Limited to “Political Subdivisions/Entities”

- ❖ Municipalities
- ❖ Water Districts
- ❖ Special Service Districts

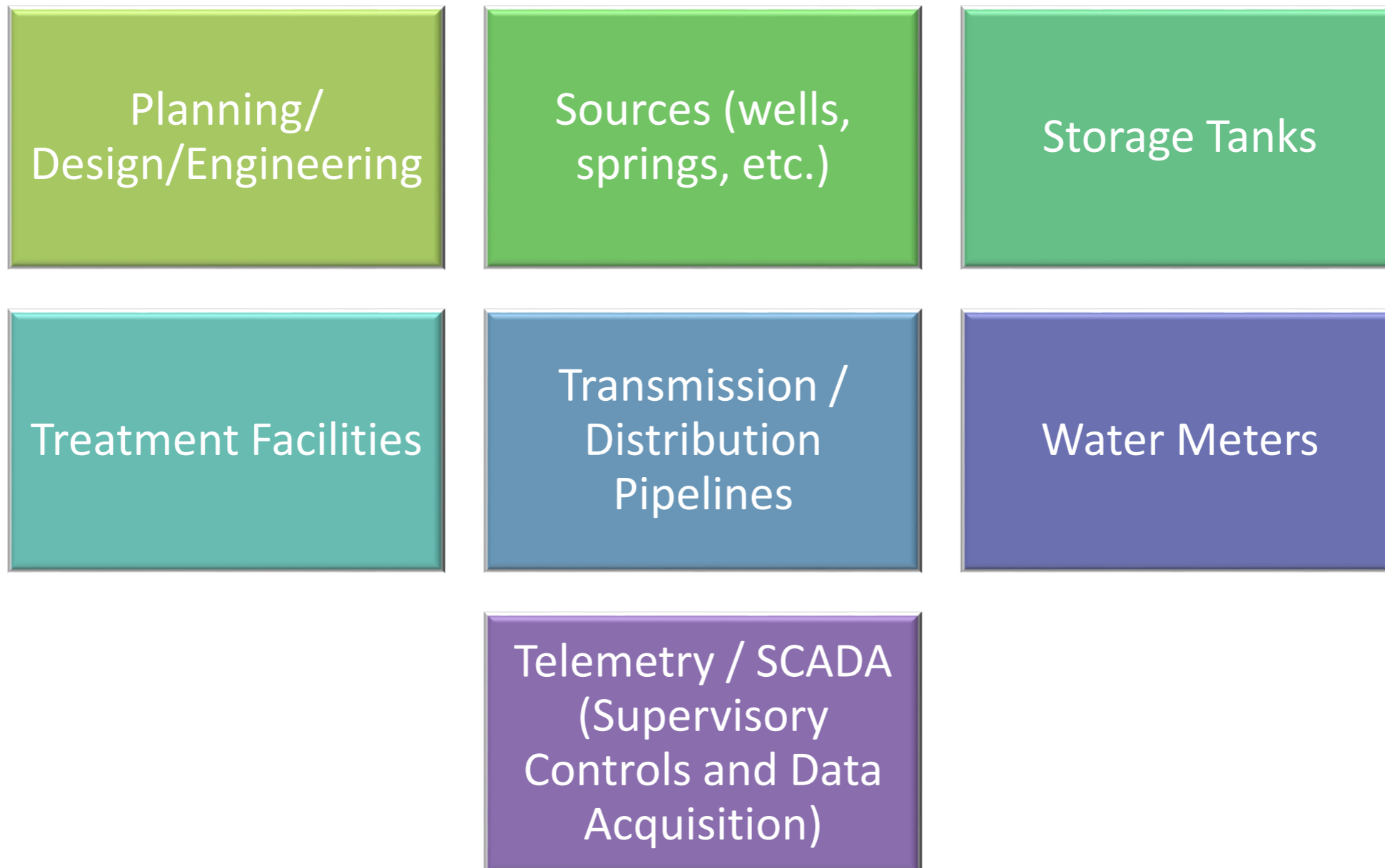
### Federal Program (R309-705)

Publicly owned systems, privately owned systems, or non-profit, non-community systems

- ❖ Municipalities, Improvement Districts, etc.
- ❖ HOAs, “Mom & Pop” Systems, etc.
- ❖ Church Camps, Scout Camps, etc.

# Drinking Water State Revolving Fund

## Loan Eligibility Criteria

### Additional Federal Program

Public Drinking Water System must be compliant with Drinking Water Standards

Public Drinking Water System must have adequate "capacity"

Environmental Assessment

Davis- Bacon Wage Requirements

Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Requirements

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# Drinking Water State Revolving Fund

## Funding Options

### Low Interest Loans

- Base rate is the RBBI, 3.92% (June 21, 2019)

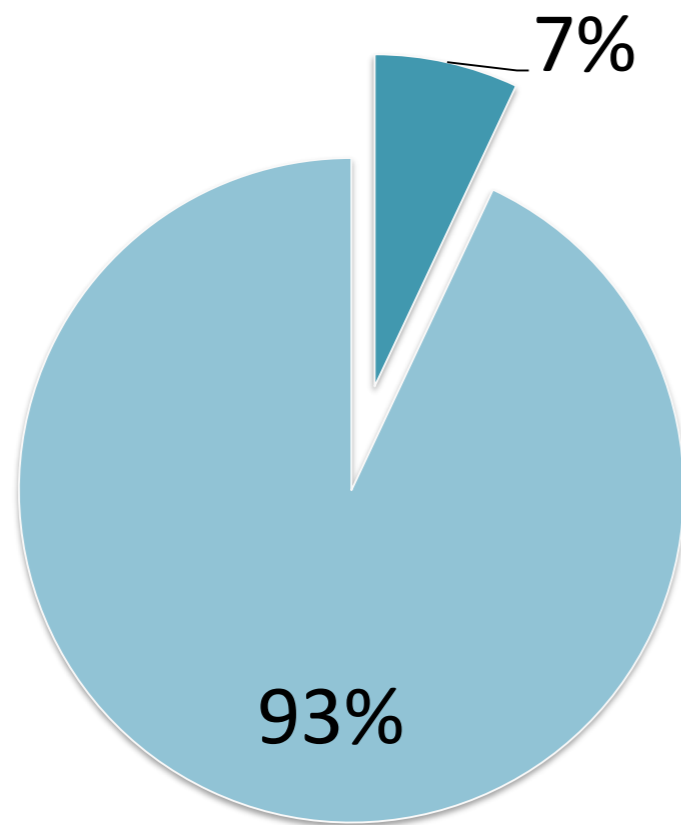
### Hardship Grant (State SRF)

- Local MAGI  $\leq$  80% of State-MAGI (median adjusted gross income)
- 2017 State MAGI \$45,895
- After project water bill  $>$ 1.75% of local MAGI
